Thank you for taking the time to come to Parent-Teacher Conferences. We hope you found this information to be very valuable. Our philosophy is educating the whole child. Therefore, our curriculum is broken into 3 stages of development: social/emotional, intellectual and physical. Our curriculum follows the PA State Standards and every year the surrounding school districts tell us how well prepared our students are for kindergarten. The area of development the kindergarten teachers appreciate most from our students is the social and emotional. We like to say "we are laying a solid foundation" for our students to build a strong education upon. Please know that each day your child is here they are working on developing and mastering these skills through fun, developmentally appropriate activities and lessons which will prepare them for kindergarten. The specific skills we are working on for each month are always found on your monthly calendar that is sent home by your teachers. It is important for parents to also help reinforce these skills we are teaching. We are very excited to have our favorite story teller, Clem Bowen, visit our school early April and share his interactive story about spring planting! Clem has been visiting us for several years now and the children absolutely loved him! Our students have been learning about seeds and planting and Clem's story will be the perfect way to enhance this theme. This lively, funny, and participatory performance will be a fun way to wrap up this unit. Demonstrations of instruments and many other visuals will really bring this story alive!

April will also bring a fun, active enrichment opportunity for our 4 & 5 year old students karate! KSPC dad and owner of Magnus Karate (See p13 for details), Sensei Mike Pannulla, will join us for a karate event. This session will feature an obstacle course that focuses on motor skills development running, jumping, leaping, skipping, age appropriate basic karate skills such as kicking, striking, and blocking, and will end with a fun karate game putting all these skills into use. Thank you, Mike and Magnus Karate, for bringing this awesome opportunity to our school!

Another fun April activity will be a playdate at Sunny Day Play Cafe (See p13 for details) located in Kennett Square!! While our teachers are participating in a teacher-inservice day, our families have the opportunity to play with friends at this awesome interactive play cafe! One of my very favorite units here at KSPC is our Plants and Seeds Unit. Each Spring all of our students experience "being farmers" who plant and care for seeds and bulbs. Nixon Park's Community Garden and planting what we have grown! On your child's planting day all classes will meet at Anson B. Nixon Park to plant what they have grown and then enjoy the park with their friends! It makes for a very meaningful learning experience, which is our main goal here at KSPC! One of the best parts of this experience is that everything picked from our garden is donated to the Kennett Food Cupboard so families may have fresh vegetables. We are very grateful to have this wonderful partnership with Anson B. Nixon's Community Garden and the Kennett Food Cupboard! We are also VERY GRATEFUL to Jen Belton for all of her time and effort to make this happen. More details about this event will be coming later this spring!

April will wrap up with our Annual Spring Consignment Sale, which will be held April 24th to April 26th. We appreciate all the time and planning that our committee has put into this event.
